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Subject Area	Requirement		
English	4 credits		
World Language	3 credits (in the same language within the Upper School)		
History	<b>3.5 credits</b> (World History I, World History II, United States History and Issues in Democracy*)		
Math	<b>4 credits</b> (Algebra I, Algebra II, Geometry required; 3 credits must be completed in the Upper School years)		
Science	3 credits (Biology, Chemistry, Physics)		
Fine Arts	<b>1.5 credits</b> (0.5 credits in each music, drama, and visual art)		
Non-Major	<b>1.5 credits</b> (Speech, Ethics, and Wellness)		
Electives	As necessary to assure a minimum of 5 classes in senior year		

\*AP Government may be substituted for Issues in Democracy.
