Founded in 1870, [The Webb School](#) is a private day and boarding school in Bell Buckle, Tennessee. Students from grades 6 -12 come from all over the world seeking college preparatory school education in liberal arts. With 10 Rhodes Scholars among its graduates and consistently high SAT scores, The Webb School has a reputation of being one of the top private boarding schools in the nation. Webb's small school community and its emphasis on honor truly create a home-like environment for its approximate 330 day and boarding students. The 150-acre campus is located in a rural setting 50 miles southeast of Nashville. Approximately 50% of the upper school's student population is boarding. At present, the school enrolls students from 12 U.S. states and 17 countries.

The Webb School seeks a full-time History Teacher for the 2021-2022 school year. This teacher will work collaboratively with other department members and is responsible for inclusive classroom instruction in a dynamic and enthusiastic manner. Teachers at The Webb School will remain current in best practices of their content area and must have strong communication skills. Embracing the mission of the school and its Enduring Understandings, this teacher will know how to bring the “hidden curriculum” into their classes as well as their advisory.
