The Webb School ELL Program Admission and Placement

All non-English speaking international students must submit the following:

- 1. Application
- 2. Essay
- 3. Transcript
- 4. Letters of recommendation
- 5. TOEFL, TOEFL Jr., IELTS, iTEP or Duolingo test scores
- 6. Interview (in-person or Zoom)

The first indicator for student admission is student test scores. The Webb School's goal when admitting and placing students is to ensure the best opportunity possible for academic success, as well as provide the best preparation for admission to top colleges and universities when they leave The Webb School.
