

The Webb School -- ELL Program Placement Guidelines

All non-English speaking international students must submit the following:

1. Application
2. Transcript
3. A writing sample
4. Letters of recommendation
5. TOEFL, TOEFL Jr., IELTS, or iTEP SLATE test score

The first indicator for student admission is student test scores. The Webb School's goal when admitting and placing students is to ensure the best opportunity possible for academic success, as well as provide the best preparation for admission to top colleges and universities when they leave The Webb School.

Students placed in ELL Intermediate must complete ELL Advanced before transitioning into the regular classroom.

The admissions committee will also examine factors such as whether the student has previously studied in an English speaking academic institution, previous coursework (particularly in literature and writing), how successful they have been academically, and verbal abilities demonstrated in their interview.
